NEUROSURGICAL CONGRESS HAVANA TRIP

Time is short and specific commitments must now be made for the Congress Travel Club trip to Havana. We hope you are planning on it, for if you are not we believe you will be disappointed and miss a real opportunity for relaxation, fellowship, and additional scientific information. Here are the travel plans:

- 1. Leave New Orleans, 7:25 PM, Saturday or Sunday, November 14 or 15, via Delta-Chicago & Southern Airlines, flying direct to Havana. (There is but one flight daily after 1:00 PM accommodating 40 passengers. We anticipate 80-100 travelers; therefore, two days will be required to accommodate all first come, first served. Wives may take flight at 9:30 AM Saturday if they wish.
- 2. Rest and relaxation, Hotel Nacional de Cuba, Havana's finest.
- 3. Monday AM, November 16, International meeting with Cuban Society of Neurology and Psychiatry.

Monday PM - Tour of Havana hospitals and city.

- 4. Tuesday AM, November 17 Travel via air-conditioned bus $(l\frac{1}{2} \text{ hours})$ to Kawama Club, Varadero Beach, where it will be "sun and sand" "til Sunday, November 22 (longer if you wish, or if necessary shorter).
- 5. Back to the mill, but relaxed and ready to really hit it hard. Come on, let's go!

Let's look at the cost of this "vacacion fantasia". Roughly, it will be \$220.00 per person, round trip from New Orleans, including everything except your meals in Havana, bar chits, gambling misfortunes, and wife's indiscretions. Kawama Club is American Plan. You never guessed it would be that reasonable! Why, you can't afford to stay home. And on top of all this, not an arrangement to worry about.

Now, here are a couple of additional advantages. If you are planning to travel by air to New Orleans and to take the Havana trip, you can make a substantial saving in your travel fare by purchasing round trip passage from your place of departure to Havana. In addition to this, you are allowed 66 pounds of luggage per person instead of the usual 40 pounds. Illustration of the possible savings per person from certain key cities is indicated below; this, of course, applies to any city from which you might be departing. As you see from the outline, apparently the airlines figure the West Coasters are well-heeled and don't need to economize.
